At the completion of this program, participants will:

- appreciate the nature and context of TMR road construction projects from the Contractor's perspective.
- be familiar with common road construction work activities and their associated resourcing, procedures, specifications, and management strategies.
- be aware of general Quality Management principles and terminologies concepts that relate to the delivery of Road Construction projects.
- understand basic estimating and tendering processes, alongside broader financial and productivity management concepts utilised by road construction contractors.
